<p>Application for Provisional Accreditation</p> <p>Provisional Accreditation should be sought for new dietetic programs and a Provisional Accreditation report, as detailed in the <i>DAA Manual for Accreditation of Dietetic Education Programs</i>, is required.</p>	<p>\$17,500 (excluding gst) – to be paid when the provisional accreditation report is provided.</p>	<p>25% levy for each extra program</p>
<p>Application for Full Accreditation</p> <p>Full accreditation should be sought within 24 months of the first graduates completing the program. A Full Accreditation report is required (detailed in the <i>DAA Manual for Accreditation of Dietetic Education Programs</i>) for this phase of accreditation.</p>	<p>\$17,500 (excluding gst) – when the full accreditation report is provided.</p>	<p>25% levy for each extra program.</p>
<p>Application for re – accreditation of existing accredited courses</p> <p>Re-Accreditation is required 5 years after full accreditation is granted (however the re-accreditation report is required 12 months before the accreditation term is complete or as notified by DAA). This fee would cover the re-accreditation of both Undergraduate and Master programs if both fully accredited and if the process was completed at the same time.</p>	<p>\$17,500 (excluding gst) – to be paid when the re-accreditation report is provided.</p>	<p>25% levy for each extra program.</p>
