

## UNIVERSITY ACCREDITATION REVIEWER TERMS OF REFERENCE (General)

### University Accreditation Reviewer Pool

Membership of the University Accreditation Reviewer Pool will be by application to the Australian Dietetics Council against the selection criteria set out below.

### Role

University Accreditation Reviewers play an important role in the assessment of university accreditation reports. Reviewers work within a Review Team to review documentation and provide advice to the Australian Dietetics Council on the contents of the reports and how well the university programs meet the DAA Accreditation Standards. Reviewers come from a variety of practice settings and from across Australia.

### Function

1. Assist with the accreditation of university dietetic programs as outlined in the *University Accreditation Review Team Terms of Reference*.

### Responsibility and Reporting

1. Reviewers selected to join the University Accreditation Reviewer Pool will be responsible to the Council via the Registrar, Accreditation and Recognition Services.

### Selection Criteria

- Full APD status for at least five years
- Significant experience in dietetic education (dietetic educator, student supervisor and/or employer of new graduates)
- High level analysis skills
- Ability to meet assigned deadlines
- Flexibility to attend interstate university site visits

To be considered for the University Accreditation Reviewer Pool please forward an application addressing the above selection criteria with a current resume to the Registrar, Accreditation and Recognition Services at DAA National Office.

### Members with Advanced APD or Fellow status

AdvAPDs or Fellows are automatically eligible to be members of the University Accreditation Reviewer Pool as their applications for AdvAPD or Fellow cover the requirements for Reviewers. Expressions of interest and a current resume should be forwarded to the Registrar, Accreditation and Recognition Services at DAA National Office.
